Flannery (2 Hearts or 2 Diamonds)

An opening bid of 2♥ (or 2♦ if 2♦ isn't Mini-Roman) shows an opening hand (11-15 points) with four Spades and five Hearts. The Flannery bid was developed to allow a 4-5 major suit distribution without making an initial call of 1 Heart, followed by opener's rebid of 2♠ (normally that would show a reverse when playing 16+ point Reverses).

The Flannery conventional bid $(2 \lor or 2 \lor)$ requires an [Alert].

Responder's Calls:

Bid	Typical Meaning
2♥> Pass (or 2♦ > 2♥) [Alert]	A weak hand – signoff
2♠ [Alert]	A weak hand – signoff
3 Major [Alert]	Game-invitational in responder's suit (must have an 8-card fit) Opener rebids: Pass - signoff with minimum values 4 Major - 14-15 points, to play
2NT [Alert]	Responder is asking opener to describe the rest of the hand: All responses require an [Alert] • 3 shows 2 Diamonds, 2 Clubs and 14-15 HCP • 3 shows 2 Diamonds, 2 Clubs and 11-13 HCP • 3 shows 3 Clubs and 1 Diamond • 3 shows 3 Diamonds and 1 Club • 4 shows 4 Clubs and 0 Diamonds • 4 shows 4 Diamonds and 0 Clubs
