Two-Way Drury

Following a 3rd or 4th seat opening bid of **1**♠/**1**♥ responder (initially a passed hand) holding 10-11 HCP can bid **2 Clubs or 2 Diamonds** to ask if partner opened lite.

Bid	Typical Meaning
P > P > 1♥/♠ > P > 2♣ [Alert]	2♣ is artificial, showing 10-12 points and 4-card trump support.
P > P > 1 ♥ / ♠ > P > 2 ♦ [Alert]	2♦ is artificial, showing 10-12 points and 3-card trump support.
P > P > 1♥/♠ > P > 2♥/♠ [Alert]	Responder is showing a simple raise (6-9 HCP) with 3-4 card support.

Once Responder has initiated 2-way Drury, Opener's responses are as follows:

Opener Rebids	Typical Meaning
2♥/2♠ (i.e., rebidding opening suit at 2-Level) [Alert]	Warns inviting partner that third seat opener was made with sub-opening values, asking partner to Pass.
ANY bid except repeating the original suit at the 2-level	Provides partner a positive response that the third seat opening was based on a true opening hand, advising partner to pick the best contract.
